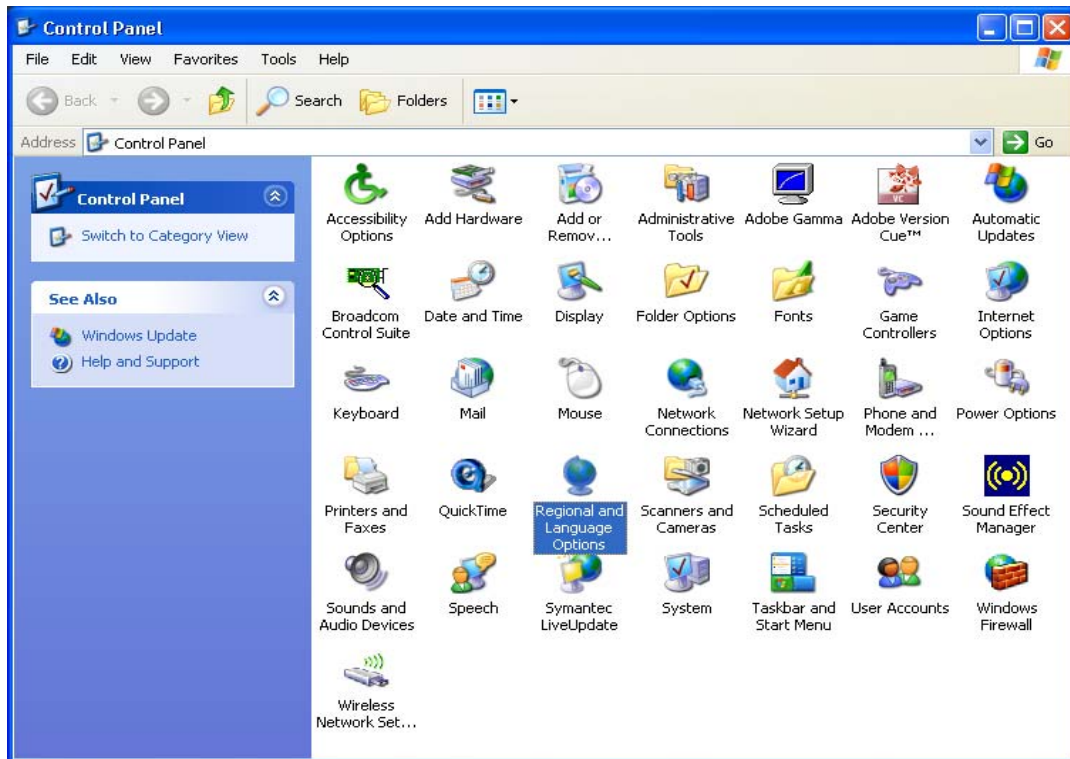
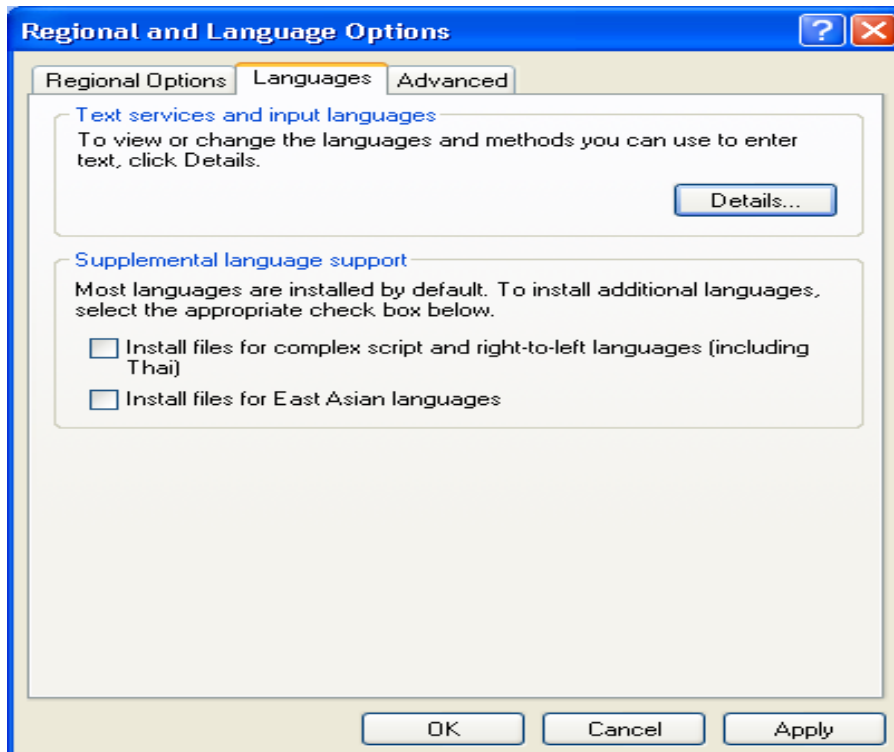


In order to be able to type, the US-INTERNATIONAL KEYBOARD MUST BE INSTALLED.

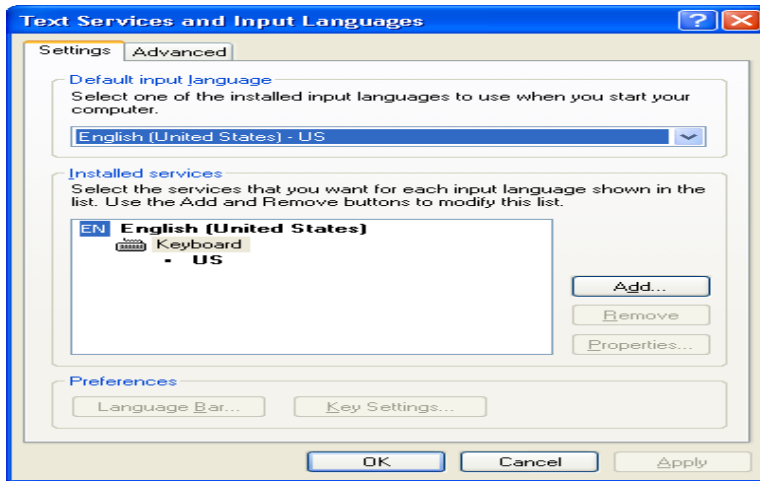
1. Go to Control Panel and double click on **Regional and Language Options**



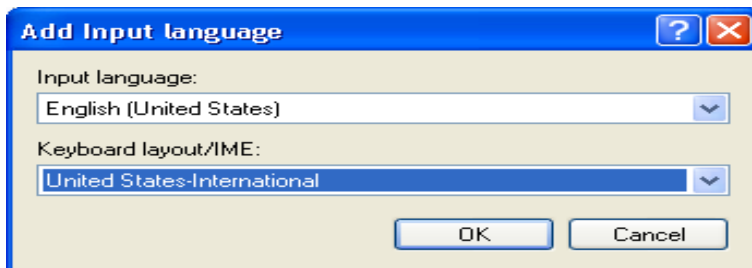
2. Click on **Languages** and then **Details...**



3. Click on **Add...**



4. In the **Add Input Language** and **Keyboard layout/IME**, select **United States-International**.



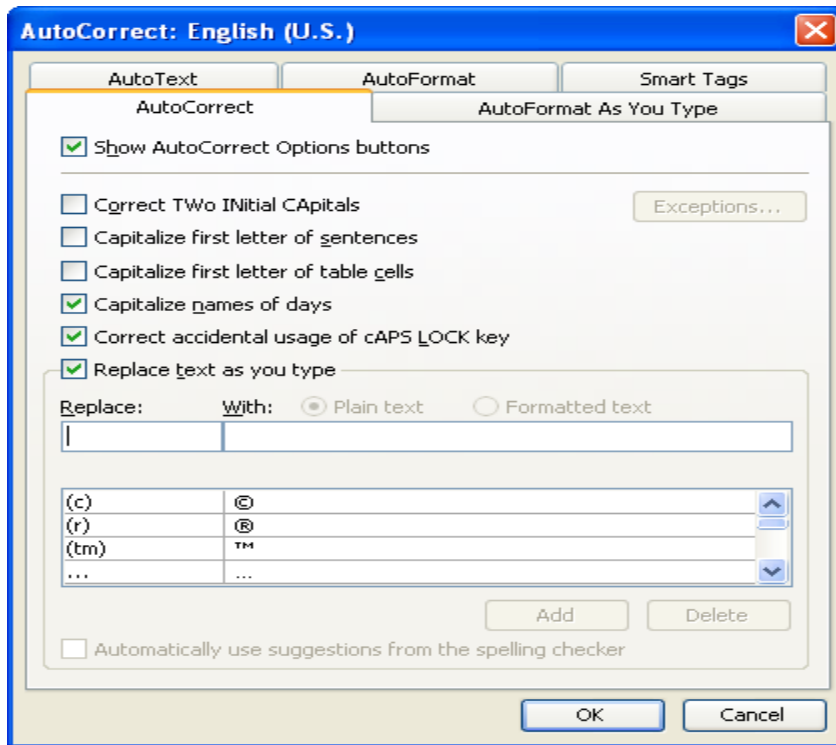
5. Click **Apply** and exit the Control Panel.



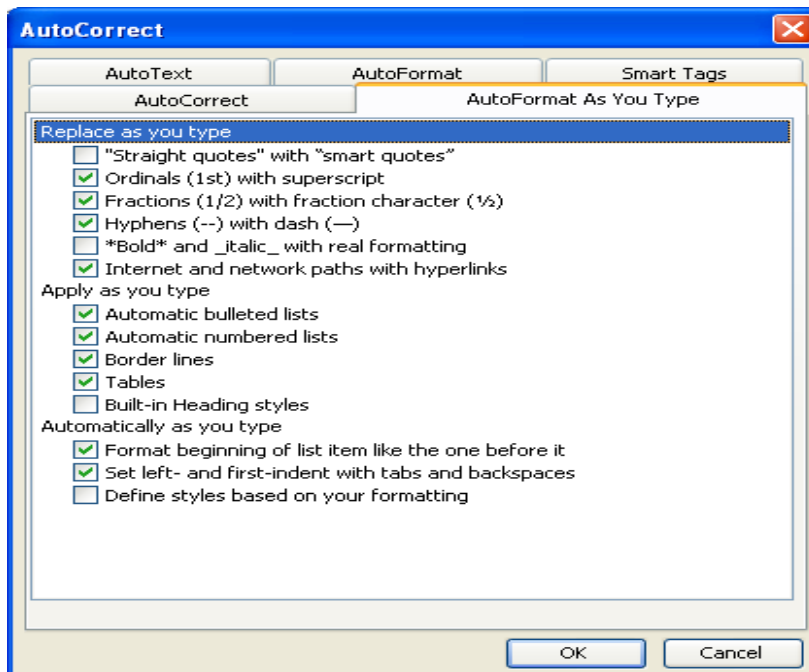
Note: After the United States-International Keyboard is added, you can remove the “US” Keyboard. By having only the United States-International Keyboard, it will allow you to **type both Khmer and English without switching Keyboard** every time you want to type Khmer. Under the “**Default input language**”, make sure that the “English (United States) – United States-International” is selected and click Apply. Lastly, remove the US Keyboard and don't forget to click the “Apply” tab again.

MAKING IT EASIER FOR KHMER TYPING - SIMPLY FOLLOW THIS INSTRUCTION

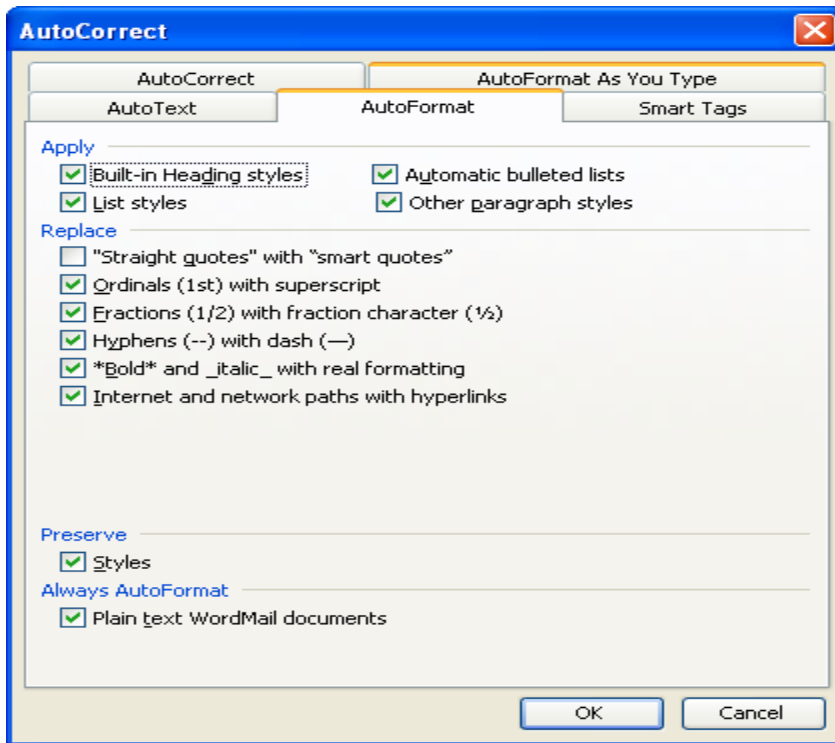
1. Open Microsoft Word
2. Go to Tools
3. Click on AutoCorrect Options...
4. Click on **AutoCorrect** tab, uncheck **Correct TWo INitial Capital**, **Capitalize first letter of sentences**, and **Capitalize first letter of table cells**.



5. Click on **AutoCorrect** tab, uncheck **"Straight quotes" with "Smart quotes"**.

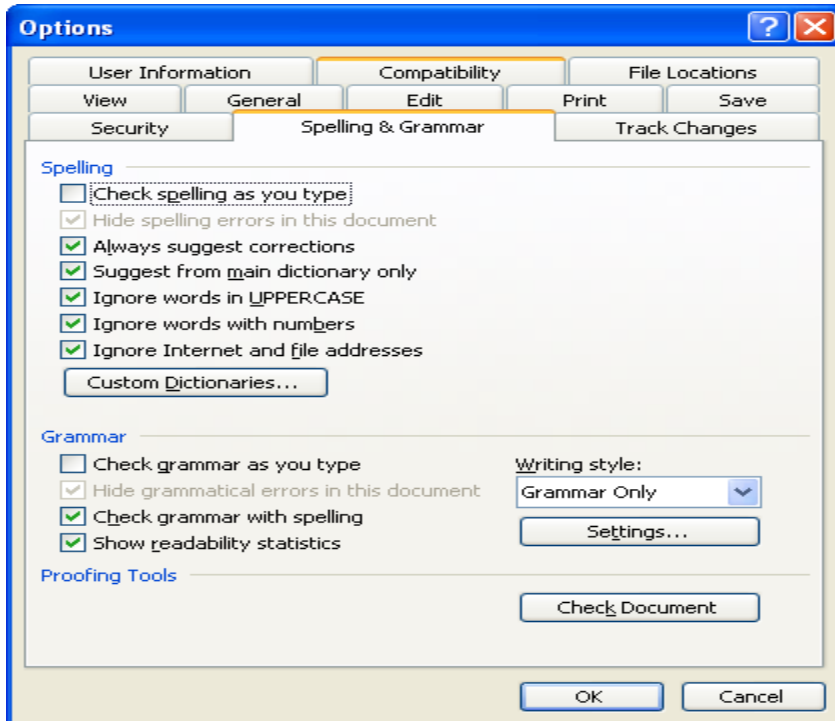


6. Click on **AutoFormat** tab, uncheck "Straight quotes" with "Smart quotes".



Now you don't want to have **RED UNDERLINE** when typing Khmer. This is because the **Spelling & Grammar** are turned on. To solve this problem, you have to do one more thing.

7. Go go Tools again and click on the **Spelling & Grammar** tab. Under the **Spelling**, uncheck **Check spelling as you type**. Under **Grammar**, uncheck **Check grammar as you type**.
